The principle: a connected box fitted in each vehicle makes it possible to collect a range of useful information, detect sources of energy waste and identify behaviours to reduce fuel consumption. Through a mobile app, drivers benefit from personalised coaching on ecodriving, combined with fun activities, team challenges, etc. The WeNow solution also makes it possible to offset all CO₂ emissions for vehicle fleets by funding <u>UN-approved projects*</u> and operations to plant trees in France.
